The following anonymized project profiles illustrate the scope, volume and results of our work across healthcare implementation, digital health, emergency readiness, cardiac networks and prevention programmes.

1. Multi-Specialty Outpatient Health Centre

Operational blueprint for converting a non-clinical building into a regulatory-ready ambulatory care centre. Scope included 1,043 m² of clinical area, 135 rooms, 10 specialties, clinical pathways, technical infrastructure, hygiene workflows, room specifications and digital patient-journey design.

Capability tags: Healthcare facility planning, operational design, regulatory readiness

2. Women's Diagnostics & Digital Imaging Pilot

Managed digital health pilot for two public hospitals, combining digital imaging, women's diagnostic imaging, electronic prescriptions, pharmacy controls, Arabic-language training and executive dashboards. Proposed budget: USD 1.48M-2.75M setup plus USD 27K-52K/month managed service.

Capability tags: Digital imaging, e-prescribing, pharmacy control, dashboards

3. AED Emergency Readiness Infrastructure

Public safety infrastructure model for a national AED network. Scope included 200 AED pilot units, 3,000-unit national rollout target, first-responder training, local operator delivery and programme-level compliance dashboards.

Capability tags: AED network, public safety, readiness reporting, managed service

4. Tertiary Cardiac Care Network

Three-centre cardiac network model with chest-pain units, national registry, STEMI pathways, quality office, workforce strategy, procurement control and phased capital expansion. Recommended Phase 1 budget: €12M.

Capability tags: Cardiac network, registry, chest-pain pathways, quality governance

5. Blindness Prevention & eHealth Programme

Lean hub-and-spoke ophthalmology programme covering cataract, diabetic retinopathy, glaucoma, keratoconus and refractive error. Year 1 optimized funding: USD 4.01M, with automation-enabled screening, recall and Ministry-level dashboards.

Capability tags: Ophthalmology, screening, eHealth, teleophthalmology
